## Fire Chief

Dartmouth Fire District 2 (DFD2) is seeking qualified individuals for the position of Fire Chief. The Fire Chief is a Full-Time employee of the District. Applicants must have a minimum of 20 years of experience in an organized fire department with at least five years of experience in a command capacity as a company officer or higher rank, or a combination of education, training and experience which provides the knowledge, skills and abilities required for the position. Dartmouth Fire District 2 is a combination Fire Department that covers a primarily residential and agricultural area of the Town of Dartmouth, Massachusetts. It operates under a Fire District form of government with a three-member elected Prudential Committee as the Executive Branch and an Open Annual District Meeting as the Legislative Branch. The Fire Chief is appointed by the Prudential Committee and has powers and duties pursuant to MGL Special Acts of 2016 Chapter 69. (<https://malegislature.gov/Laws/SessionLaws/Acts/2016/Chapter69>).

In addition to the full-time Fire Chief, there are currently 2 full-time firefighters who work Monday – Friday during normal business hours and 24 on call firefighters. DFD 2 operates out of 1 fire station and has a small fleet of fire apparatus and specialty vehicles.

The salary range is \$85,000-\$95,000 and will be determined through the execution of an employment contract with the candidate. The position requires district residency within nine months of employment.
